Important Note: Fees below do not include the Alberta and Canadian Fencing Association memberships, which can vary from \$15 (Recreation) to \$50 (Competitive). AFA/CFF membership is valid from September 2009 to August 2010. Note: To compete in provincial or national fencing competitions you must have a competitive membership.

Family Discount – Families who have two fencers registered in classes twice per week may register the second fencer for \$150 less per term. Regular AFA fees still apply. (This discount does *not* apply to once-per-week classes.)

Fees stated below are for one session only. ALL FENCERS MUST BUY A GLOVE (\$20). (available from coach)
